The Beaver Pond Forest, the Trillium Woods, and the rest of the South March Highlands have the highest ecological value and biodiversity of any area in the City of Ottawa – with 679 native species, 164 bird species and 18 species at risk. Yet the City of Ottawa and Urbandale/ Richcraft plan on destroying it by clear cutting the trees and then blasting the region flat to put up homes.
